BASIC RULES AND TEAM CATEGORIES - COURAGE CLASSIC 2010 LAW ENFORCEMENT, MILITARY AND CIVILIAN

The Courage Classic Law Enforcement, Military and Civilian Charity Shooting Match recognizes placement for the top 3 to 4-person teams in the following categories:

- 1. LAW ENFORCEMENT CATEGORY:** All team members must be current full time or current active reserve law enforcement officers from the same agency. All team members must utilize department approved duty gear (firearms & holster etc.) and a hat, shirt or uniform that identifies the team members and the department which they represent.
- 2. MILITARY CATEGORY:** Team members must be either full time or active reserve military and designated by clothing (hat or shirt or uniform) from the same branch and must utilize current or former military firearms or Match Director approved civilian replica.
- 3. CIVILIAN and SPECIAL CATEGORIES:** Several special categories are available depending on interest, PILOTS, FIRE DEPARTMENT, and the like are available should more than one team in the desired category enter.

This is a "Time Plus" scored match. Raw time plus any penalties added or bonuses subtracted equals your final score. Lowest score for completed match wins. Range commands and basic safety rules closely follow the USPSA model.

"LIMITED" - No scopes, no comps, no bipods. Shotgun mag tubes must not extend past the end of the barrel more than 1.00". Handgun magazine length 140mm max.

"TACTICAL" - One OPEN gun and two LIMITED guns.

"OPEN" - Anything goes, however, the configuration of each firearm at the start of the first stage that firearm is used, is the configuration it must stay in for the entire match. Any modifications or substitutions must be approved by the match director.

Teams must be declared prior to the 09:30 match start time.

All holsters must be able to pass a retention test, cover the trigger guard and point the muzzle within one meter of the competitors feet.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICATION

- The match entry fee is \$50 per individual competitor or \$150 per team (lunches for both days included **IF** registration is received by July 15th) and is not refundable. Mail this completed application and check to: **Kitsap Rifle & Revolver Club, 4900 Seabeck Hwy. NW, Bremerton, Washington, 98312**. Applications must be filled out completely.
- You must be prepared to supply copies of I.D. cards in the event questions of eligibility for specific categories arise. Failure to provide verifying documents could result in not being qualified to compete in the special categories.
